



Breeder's Guarantee (Effective 01/08/2022)

Canine Hip or Elbow Dysplasia

Breeder offers a 30 month guarantee against the dog contracting Canine Hip Dysplasia (CHD) or Elbow Dysplasia (ED).

If it is determined that the dog is affected by CHD or ED during its initial 30 months of life, and all terms and conditions of the Sales Agreement have been adhered to, Buyer may choose another available/upcoming puppy. Buyer will need to provide Breeder verified x-rays and confirmation of the findings (from Pennhip, OFA or similar Kennel Club approved scheme). Breeder reserves the right to request a second opinion from another licensed vet or specialised professional of Breeder's choice. After Breeder's review and concurrence, and upon verification that the affected dog has since been neutered/spayed, Buyer may choose another available/upcoming puppy that Breeder deems will be a good fit for the Buyer. Buyer may keep their original dog as well. Breeder's financial responsibility will be limited to replacement of the puppy/dog. All veterinary care/testing bills accumulated by Buyer are the financial responsibility of the Buyer.

Specific Genetic Disorders

Breeder offers a lifetime guarantee that the dog will not contract any of the following genetic disorders prevalent to Labrador Retrievers: Progressive Rod-Cone Degeneration (PRCD), Exercise Induced Collapse (EIC), Centronuclear Myopathy (CNM), Degenerative Myelopathy (DM), Skeletal Dysplasia (Type 2), Hereditary Nasal Parakeratosis (HNPK) or Cystinuria.

If it is determined that the dog is affected by one of the aforementioned genetic diseases during its lifetime, Breeder will offer Buyer another puppy. Buyer will need to provide confirmation of the findings (from a licensed qualified veterinarian/specialist). After Breeder's review and concurrence, and upon verification that the affected dog has since been neutered/spayed, Buyer may choose another available/upcoming puppy that Breeder deems will be a good fit for the Buyer. Buyer may keep their original dog as well. Breeder's financial responsibility will be limited to replacement of the puppy/dog. All veterinary care/testing bills accumulated by Buyer are the financial responsibility of the Buyer.

Cryptorchidism (Undescended) or Monorchidism (Single) Testicle

Breeder offers to reimburse any additional surgical cost, in excess of a standard neuter cost for that clinic, and limited to a maximum of \$200, for the neutering of any cryptorchid or monorchid Skylit Labrador as long as the procedure was performed no earlier than the minimum age specified for neutering in that dog's Sales Agreement.

Entropion

Breeder offers to reimburse any additional corrective surgical or treatment cost, limited to a maximum of \$500, due to Entropion in any Skylit Labrador where the initial condition was identified in writing by a qualified veterinarian and Breeder was informed prior to the puppy turning 5 months of age.
